

Virologic Surveillance

This week **482** lab-confirmed tests were reported. In the current flu season, there have been 64,078 lab-confirmed tests reported.



Influenza-Like Illness Surveillance

The percent of patient visits to sentinel providers for an influenza-like illness (ILI) was 2.5%, which is below South Carolina's baseline (3.2%). The ILI activity level overall was minimal.

Influenza-Associated Hospitalizations

This week 58 influenza-associated hospitalizations were reported by 53 hospitals. The cumulative hospitalization rate is 91.6 per 100,000. In the current flu season, there have been 4654 influenza-associated hospitalizations.

Influenza-Associated Deaths

This week, 2 influenza-associated deaths were reported; however, the deaths occurred during previous weeks. The cumulative mortality rate is 2.3 per 100,000. In the current flu season, there have been 116 influenza-associated deaths.







Laboratory-Confirmed Influenza Cases, 2021-22 Season to Present





Influenza-Like Illness (ILI) Surveillance


This week, the ILI activity level was **minimal** and **2.5%** of patient visits to SC ILINet providers were attributed to an influenza-like illness. This is **below** the state baseline of **3.2%**.

Reports were received from providers in **21** counties, representing all DHEC Public Health regions.

ILI percentage is dependent upon the number of reporting providers and/or can vary by disease activity or the number of providers submitting reports.


