Notice of Modification of Mine Operating Permit I-000601 (Mod 19-2)

Haile Gold Mine, Lancaster County

South Carolina's Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) has completed the review of information submitted for the modification of mine operating permit I-000601 (Mod 19-2) for Haile Gold Mine, requested by Haile Gold Mine, Inc. (Operator). This review process included information submitted by the Operator; comments from governmental agencies, including a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and DHEC as cooperating agencies; and other interested parties.

You are receiving this memorandum as an interested member of the public that requested to be notified. With this approval and receipt of the required financial assurance, DHEC is modifying the Mine Operating Permit I-000601 for the Haile Gold Mine. Pursuant to SC Code Section 44-1-60(E)(2), "[t]he staff decision becomes the final agency decision fifteen calendar days after notice of the staff decision has been mailed to the applicant, unless a written request for final review accompanied by filing fee is filed with the department by the applicant, permittee, licensee, or affected person."
