South Carolina's Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) has completed the review of information submitted for the mine operating permit for the Enoree Development Site Quarry, requested by Luck Stone Corporation (Operator). This review process included information submitted by the Operator, comments from governmental agencies, and the interested public. With this approval and receipt of the required financial assurance, DHEC is issuing the Mine Operating Permit I-002335 for the Enoree Development Site Quarry.
