Dear Mr. Lanier.

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (Department) has reviewed and approves the workplan for the Expanded ABC+ Pilot Study. In the workplan TRC Environmental Corporation (TRC) will conduct a comprehensive, baseline groundwater before the implementation of the injections. The Department noticed that the request made is for (15) direct push multi-interval borings (DPT), however the map only shows eight (8). Please clarify the difference in the DPT. The Department recommends adding DPT points around the areas RMW-08, RMW-23, and RMW-28. An Underground Injection permit is required and can be obtained through the Bruce Crawford, Bureau of Water. As part of the work plan, no injection activities conducted within 30 feet of an existing monitoring wells.

The expanded pilot study shall be conducted over a twelve (12) month period. An analytical baseline will be conducted pre-injection, at six (6) months following the injections a second comprehensive groundwater monitoring event will be conducted and DPT points will be used to gain additional information. Once this data has been collected and a report drafted, a meeting with Department should be schedule to discuss the results and progress of the expanded pilot study.
