






Water Program Budget Distribution


- The following graph's dollar amounts include all personnel (fringe and overhead)

Water and Wastewater Construction

\$3,000 - Individual

\$5,000 - Combined

Approval to Place into Operation

\$1,000 to \$2,000 additive

*In addition to standard Construction Review Fees.
