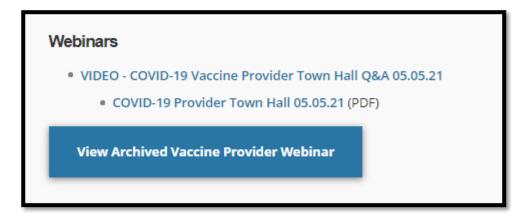

VAMS Janssen Vaccine Expiration Date Reminder

- June 10, 2021, the FDA approved an extension of the shelf life for the Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine from 3 months (90 days) to 4.5 months (135 days)
 - On June 22, 2021, the VAMS team has deployed a hotfix updating existing Janssen inventory to expire after 135 days
 - Any new Janssen inventory can be logged with the new expiration timeline



VAMS 5.1 Release Notes

Clinic Portal Updates

- The inventory tab is now available to all clinic administrators and inventory managers
- Appointment notes can be sent in Spanish or English for standard/mobile clinics
- Clinic administrators for standard/mobile clinics can view operating hours for treatment stations while remaining on the Clinic Setup tab
- Clinic administrators for standard/mobile clinics can view absences for treatment stations while remaining on the Clinic Setup tab
- A warning message will appear for standard/mobile clinics if treatment station group operating hours are set outside of clinic location operating hours
- Clinic administrators for standard/mobile clinics are able to enable and disable dual appointment reservations at their clinic



VAMS 5.1 Release Notes Continued

Third-Party Clinic Updates

- The Manage Recipients tab is now the Recipient Management tab
- The Bulk Imports tab is now the Data Imports tab
- The Clinic Setup tab is now available for third-party clinic administrators
- Third-party clinics are able to print and download clinic specific QR codes
- Third-party clinic administrators are able to set their clinic as Available for Scheduling

Recipient Portal Updates

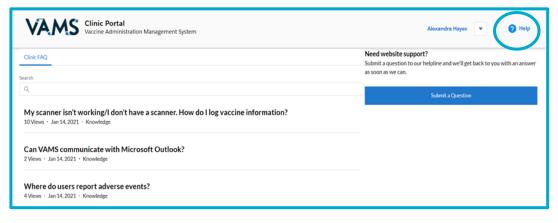
- Recipients are able to schedule group appointments for recipients within their shared VAMS account

Holiday Ordering

Pfizer Direct Ship Vaccine

- No vaccine deliveries will occur on July 5.
- Limited Saturday, July 3, deliveries are available for jurisdictions that completed the holiday order form prior to June 30, 2021 at 9;00am.

Moderna Centrally Distributed Vaccine

- No vaccine deliveries will occur on July 5 or July 6.
- Limited Saturday, July 3, deliveries for jurisdictions that need vaccine for clinics scheduled on the holiday weekend. The Holiday order template_McKesson_Independence Day 2021_v1 is available on the ISD Awardee SharePoint (COVID-19 > Distribution > Guides and Toolkits).
 - Jurisdictions must email the completed form to <u>COVIDVaccineSupport@McKesson.com</u> by Friday, July 2, at 9:00 am ET.



VTrckS Ordering Updates and Order Limit Business Rule (new!)

VTrcks ordering updates include:

- On June 24, ordering caps in VTrckS were removed. Products available for ordering include:
 - Pfizer (450 dose)
 - Moderna (10 dose)
 - Moderna (14 dose)
- All Johnson & Johnson's Janssen and Pfizer's 1170 dose COVID-19 vaccine packages are currently unavailable for ordering in VTrckS.
- As of June 24, VTrckS will not allow orders larger than 10,000 doses. Guidance will be provided for orders over this amount soon.
- The shipping cadence for vaccine and ancillary kit orders will remain the same.
- Awardees and partners are free to order vaccine as they need it but are encouraged to order only what is needed and to use what is ordered.

Moderna EUA Adolescent Vaccination Program Preparation

- Vaccine order configurations will not change in response to this EUA update. Moderna orders
 will continue to contain the same number of doses in the same thermal shipper and shipping
 and handling requirements.
- Ancillary kits for Moderna 14 dose orders will come in two configurations. You will place your vaccine order with intention of either Adult or Pediatric. This information will determine which ancillary kit is shipped with the vaccine.
- All orders of remaining Moderna 10 will come with adult ancillary kits only.
- 85% of the kits are being produced as adult kits and 15% of the kits as pediatric kits to support the adolescent vaccination program.
 - Pediatric kits contain only 1" needles
 - All other kit components remail the same
 - Adult kits contain the same ratio of 1" to 1.5" needles



Moderna EUA Adolescent Vaccination Program Preparation

 Upon FDA approval of the Moderna EUA expansion, you will not need to place new orders of vaccine with pediatric kits to begin administering to adolescents. Ancillary kits currently in your inventory contain the same 1-inch needles as the pediatric kit and can be used for adolescent vaccination.



VTrckS Down Time: July 16 – 18

VTrckS will need some down-time for system maintenance and updates during the month of July. From July 16 – 18, there will be no access to VTrckS and no ability to order vaccine. The inventory in the field is very large, but if you anticipate an increased need during this period of time, please be sure to order vaccine in advance of the interruption. Specific time for this shut down will be provided next week in the Weekly Reader. We appreciate your patience while we carry out these critical updates.



Myocarditis and Pericarditis - Updated EUAs

On June 25, 2021, the FDA revised the Pfizer and Moderna EUAs regarding the suggested increased risks of myocarditis (inflammation of the heart muscle) and pericarditis (inflammation of the tissue surrounding the heart) following vaccination. Updated versions of the Moderna and Pfizer EUA Fact Sheets for Providers and Fact Sheets for Recipients and Caregivers are now posted on the FDA website.
